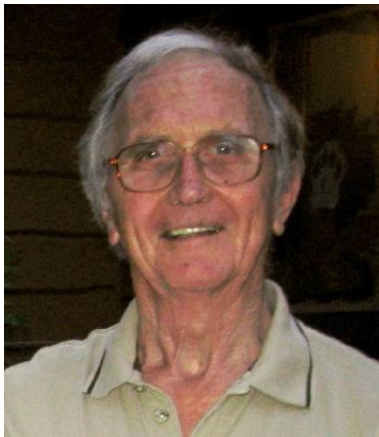


WILSON; Strathearn (Strath)

Making Ontario home in 1956, Strath worked at National Research Council (1956-58), sang with the Canadian Opera Company Chorus (1959-64), taught Immunology at University of Toronto (1960-74), and was employed in various capacities at Connaught Medical Research Laboratories (Pasteur Mérieux Connaught) 1958-1997. After retiring, Strath enjoyed downhill skiing at Blue Mountain Resort; kayaking and bicycling in warmer seasons. Singing, making puns, and reading were favourite pastimes.
